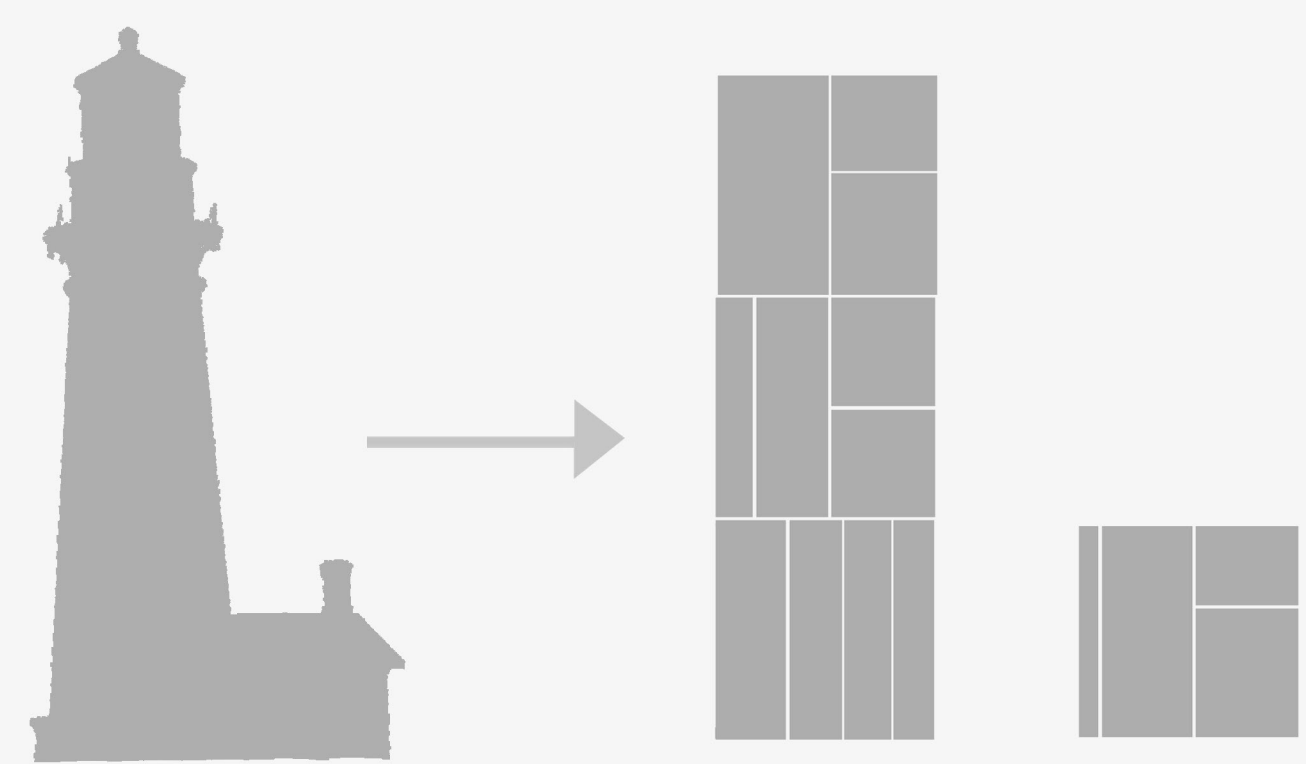
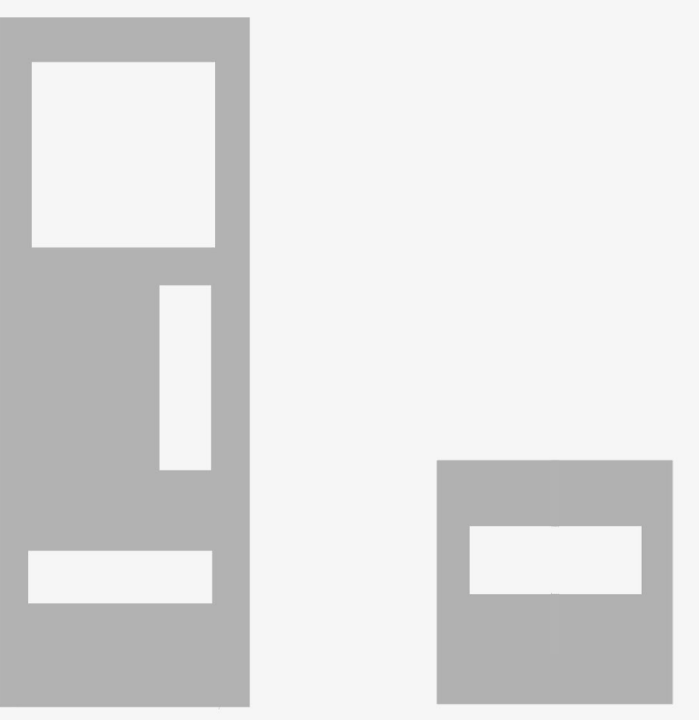
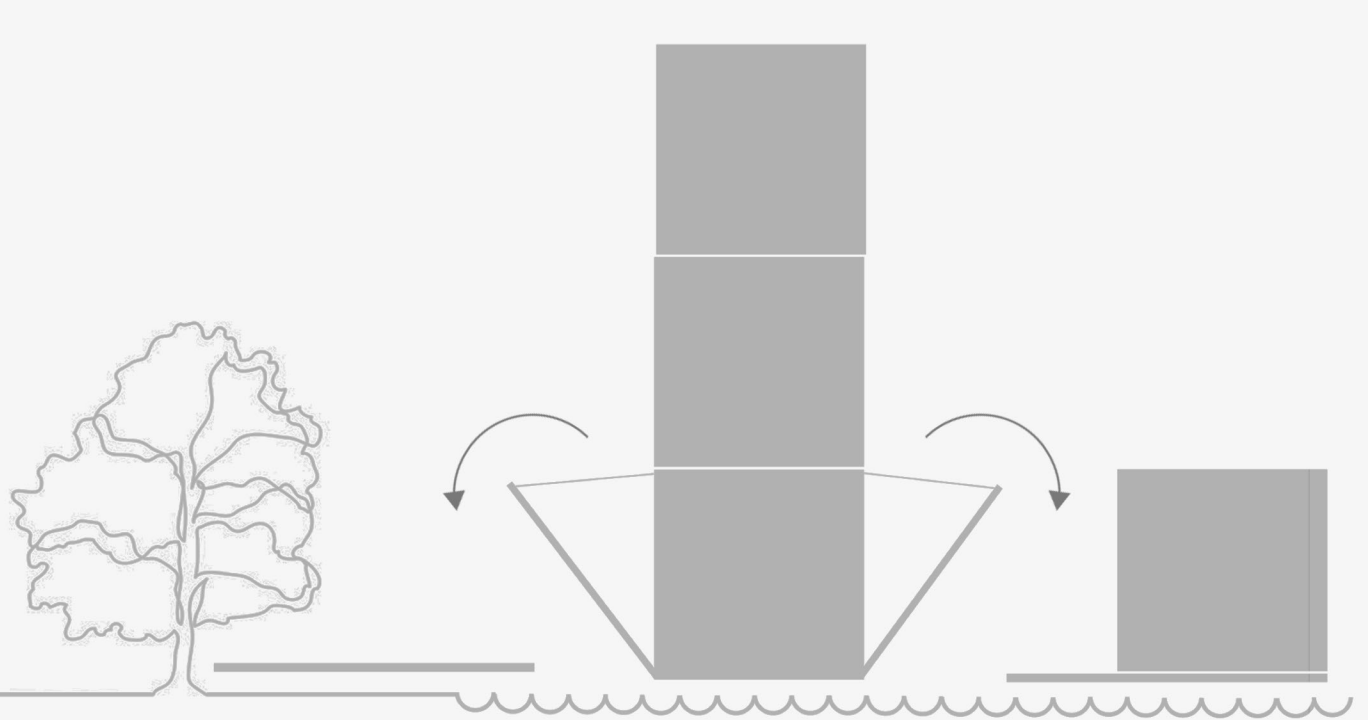


# LIGHTHOUSE CABIN



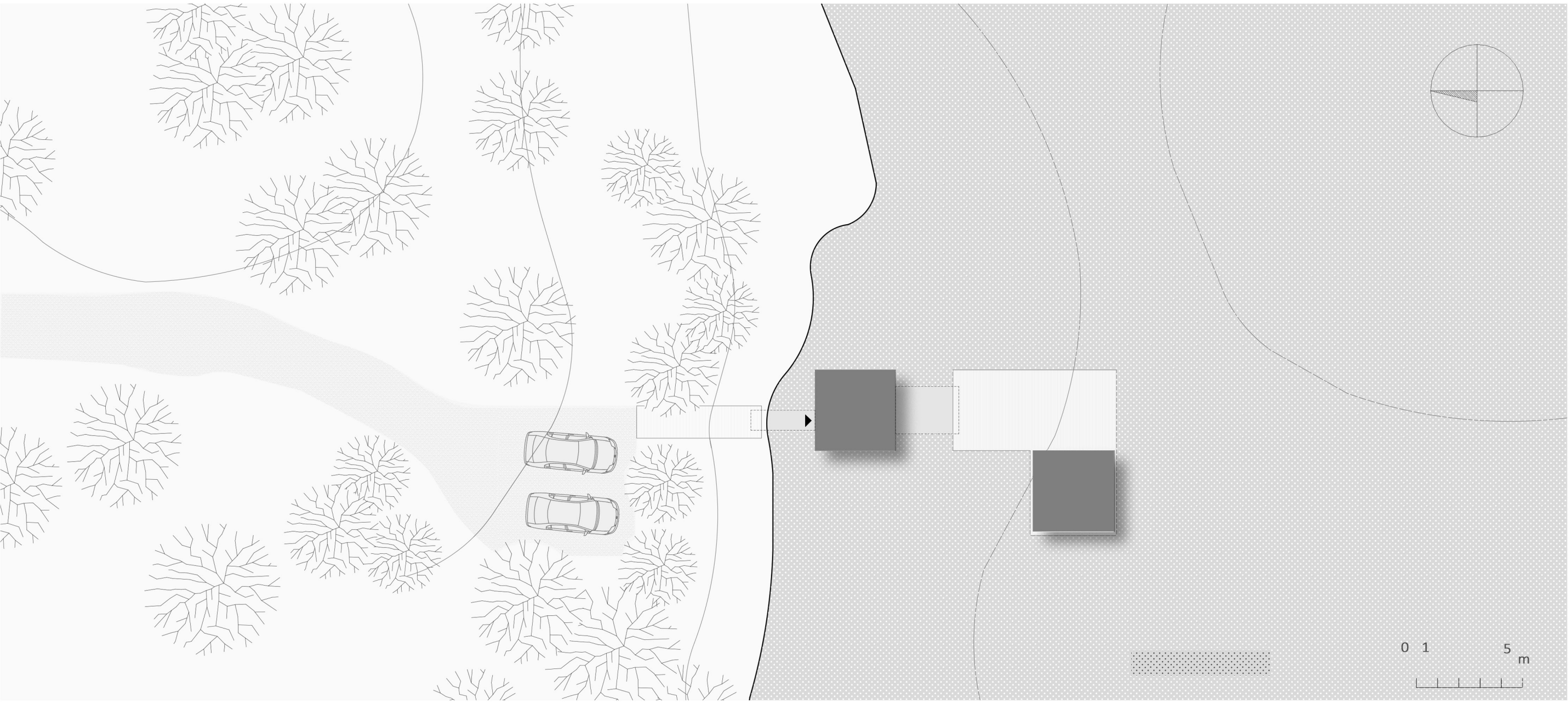
THE FORM OF THE BUILDING RELATES TO THE ARCHETYPE OF THE SEA LIGHTHOUSE. RESTORED IN A MODERN WAY WITH CUBE MODULES, BUILDING PROVIDES RESIDENTS GREAT VIEW FROM ALL LEVELS AND VARIOUS PERSPECTIVES. AN IMPORTANT ASPECT OF THIS SOLUTION IS ALSO THE MINIMUM OF BUILT-UP AREA.

THE FUNCTIONAL LAYOUT OF THE BUILDING IS DIVIDED ON MODULAR UNITS, WHERE EVERY UNIT HAS ASSIGNED INDIVIDUAL FUNCTION FOR COMFORTABLE USE AND THE POSSIBILITY OF SHAPING DIFFERENT BUILDING OPTIONS.



THE BUILDING IS LOCATED ON THE LAKE LINE, CREATING A NATURAL MOAT AROUND THE BUILDING. THAT GIVES THE USER SENSE OF SECURITY AND CUT-OFF FROM EVERYDAY LIFE. SLIDING PANELS ALSO REDUCE THE HEAT AND GLARE OF DIRECT SUNLIGHT.

THE FACADE IS COVERED WITH GRAY PLYWOOD WHICH RESEMBLES THE CONCRETE, BUT IT IS LIGHTER AND HAS A NATURAL WOOD FACTOR FITTING INTO THE ENVIRONMENT. WINDOWS ARE ADJUSTED TO UNIQUE LANDSCAPE ELEMENTS CREATING FRAMES FOR THE VIEWS.
